I am requesting funding for Modernization of the Runway Appurtenances at the Reno-Tahoe International Airport in Nevada, in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Reno-Tahoe Airport Authority, located at 2001 E Plumb Lane, Reno, NV 89502.

The funding would modernize runway appurtenances at the Reno-Tahoe International Airport. This project is a responsible and good use of taxpayer dollars because it will modernize the Runway 8-26 edge lights (both in-pavement and elevated), Runway End Identifier Lights (REILS), Precision Approach Path Indicators (PAPIs), and other related ancillary appurtenances, at Reno-Tahoe International Airport and upgrade the edge lights to the current LED bi-directional industry and RNO airfield standards.
