I am requesting funding for the road widening and enhancement project along Curry Street in Carson City in Nevada, in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is Carson City, located at 3505 Butti Way, Carson City, NV 89701.

The funding would provide improved traffic and pedestrian circulation, improved access to south Carson City, and an enhanced storm drainage system. The current road meanders around a hill with narrow lanes and limited visibility for drivers and there is no bicycle or pedestrian infrastructure. This project is a responsible and good use of taxpayer dollars because it will widen the road to include bike lanes, provide new pedestrian connections, enhance street lighting, and provide additional stormwater infrastructure crucial for preventing flooding.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 USC 5305(a)(2).
