I am requesting funding for the Sparks Street Pedestrian Rehabilitation Project in the City of Sparks in Nevada, in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Sparks, located at 431 Prater Way, Sparks, NV 89431.

The funding would be used to replace failing roadway in a residential community near Kate Smith Elementary School in Sparks, Nevada. This roadway is located in a disadvantaged neighborhood and the area has an average Pavement Condition Index of 42 (on a scale of 0 to 100, where a PCI below 50 generally indicates failure and the need for full roadway rehabilitation). Some of these streets are falling below PCI 25. This project will rehabilitate over 415,924 square feet of Asphaltic Concrete roadway pavement. Any city-maintained underground utilities needing repair, such as sewer and storm drain infrastructure will also be included in this project. This project is a responsible and good use of taxpayer dollars because it will provide roadway improvements to improve safety for the students and the community.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133(b).
