Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for US Route 93 Safety Enhancements in Wells, NV for the Nevada Department of Transportation, in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Nevada Department of Transportation, located at 1263 Stewart St., Carson City, NV 89712.

The funding would provide safety enhancements to the community through various improvements to a 7-mile stretch of US 93 in Wells, NV. This project is a responsible and good use of taxpayer dollars because it will make improvements including shoulder widening; installation of technology to improve operational communications (ITS trunk line); construction of passing lanes, truck climbing lanes, and centerline rumble strips; and improvements of shoulder slopes and guardrail end terminals. These improvements will ease congestion, prevent traffic delays, and improve safety for the Wells community.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133(b).
